The last letter I sent to you came from Fiji. We had a great three months there, and had graduation on the last Friday, August 23. The next morning I flew to Australia to go to the Indigenous Australians, where a friend I have trained is the principal of a Christian school. It was a six hour drive. Sue, the CEF director. drove us there. One of the ladies riding in the car with us was very sick and upon arriving, she tested positive for COVID. Then Sue got very sick, and drove back to Perth not feeling well. It has been very hard as her mother and father are needing a caregiver these days. Sue's husband Ken also got sick. God spared me, and I am thankful for good health. It was a wonderful time with the children and I had the privilege of leading a young girl to the Lord who came to me afterward and said she had been thinking for a long time about believing in God. From Perth I flew to Korea for a special week of meetings for the National Directors of the Asia Pacific Region. It was a great week and very busy. Now I am in Thailand for a catch up week and spoke to the staff in Indonesia at their National Conference, joining them by Zoom. It was wonderful. Today I met with a Korean couple who are planning to go to another country to work in an International school. They have a burden for children and are very interested in CEF materials. Now, we had to cancel Papua New Guinea because of safety issues in the country. So I will be here for one more week before carrying on the schedule as before. First it will be Udon Thani, Thailand, for supervising TCE staff for Laos. Then down to New Caledonia to help them get CYIA started. Then once again I will come back to Thailand for an Instructor course, go to Korea for CMI, and finish the year visiting Singapore before flying home. Upon arrival in the States I will immediately begin Zoom classes for Indonesia for the preschool course. The days are busy. Thank you for praying, God is keeping me strong. I do struggle with back pain, so appreciate your upholding me in prayer especially for long hours of travel and sitting in the classroom. Thank you for your financial support, this enables me to keep traveling and training in so many countries.

I will send some pictures for you to see to praise the Lord for all of the students, and to rejoice at God's beautiful creation. First some of the children in Fiji during Open Air and teaching in 5Day Club. Then God's beauty in creation.
