In the span of a month, God provided enough for the entire building! It was amazing! Now we actually have the funding for 2 buildings which will be called the Lakeside Halls. This project has



been a learning and growing experience. There are so many details and moving parts. Site prep is underway as we wait for all of the correct permits and paperwork to go through. Lord willing, at least one of the buildings can be done by the end of next summer. It is awesome to see the camp continue to grow and thrive.



This year has been hard. We have a new executive director and several new managers. Our new Executive Director, Barry Holbrook, has experienced some serious health issues this year. He is doing much better, praise God! In May, the lady that Alicia had been training to take over as finance manager resigned. God was calling her elsewhere. So Alicia now again has both the finance manager and associate director roles. It is overwhelming to try to balance both. Please be praying with us that God will provide someone to come take this position. She

also did not have a coffee shop lead, so had to step in for many shifts this summer. Alicia's theme for the summer was unfailing trust in God. She definitely had a lot of practice in that area. :) We had 2 power outages with campers here. We were able to get everyone fed with some creative solutions. The day before Senior High camp started, we had a big storm with 80+ mph winds that knocked down several trees



and rearranged the water toys. Praise God for minimal damage to buildings. Through all the obstacles that Satan threw our way, we as staff may have been fazed a time or two but God was not surprised. We had many things that were breaking

and closing down, but we were able to build, fix and move forward with God's provision. Over the summer, Thomas had 25 summer staff that reported to him. He is enjoying his job as Recreation Manager, working on getting all 40+ rec

options that camp offers updated and running well.



This summer, we had record numbers of campers at our three big youth weeks: Senior high, Middle school 1 and Middle school 2. We had over 400 campers each week! Over 200 kids gave their lives to Jesus, and over 100 got baptized. Praise God! We are so blessed to be a part of this ministry that changes so many lives. One person getting saved makes all of the stress and hard work worth it. It was a hard, good, crazy, successful summer.



We just celebrated 2 years of marriage! We have faced a great deal of challenges and adventures both at camp and at home, but God is so good. We have had some amazing blessings: our garage is finished, God provided a golf cart and a truck, and we were able to take a trip in March together to get away and process. We have also had some heartbreaks: Alicia's grandpa passed away, and Thomas's parents got divorced. Through it all, God is our strength and comfort. He is our Foundation and our Provider. We dog-sat a great pyrenees named Molly for the summer. She and Ranger had great fun together. We were thankful that Ranger had company while we were so busy.
