“Why do you fly MAF?”

June explained how on her last trip to consult with Bible translators, she went by road, traveling through an insecure area where they were stopped multiple times. This meant she missed her connecting flight to her home in South Africa.

Flying on MAF was a safer, more convenient option. “It’s a gift!” she said.

The flight was a gift for us, too, to see up close the work of MAF in Mozambique (where MAF operates as Ambassador Aviation). David and I, along with two guys from our church, and Amber, a colleague from MAF, traveled to Mozambique earlier this month to lead the team conference for our MAF staff.

David and our church guys did the teaching, while Amber and I took care of the kids, including the daughter of two of our national staff. We loved interacting with the team and seeing firsthand how MAF makes a difference in the lives of isolated people in Mozambique.
