Home Office Staff & Volunteers • Both in Canada and the US, we have bookkeepers and other helpers who get to work recording information, preparing newsletter mailings, and assisting with day-to-day operations. Their assistance is an absolute blessing and allows us to keep going!

Creative Skills of the Saints • In both Mexico and Haiti, our team has been blessed with many creative skills and talents. Cooking, carpentry, artwork, music, and many more are skills that God has allowed our missionaries to use in the


process of evangelism and discipleship.
