Vasquez Family Summer Ministries and Casa Compasiva Update

Greetings from Oaxaca! Thank you for your faithful prayers and support. We are grateful for your partnership as God continues to work through the ministries here in Mexico.



This summer we organized a Bible Club during the FIFA World Cup with 23 children attending. Because of your generosity, each child received a jersey and materials.

We praise the Lord that two families visited our church for the first time and three children made professions of faith in Christ! Due to the ongoing teachers' strike and school closures, we are preparing for Vacation Bible School in July and continuing our weekly Bible Club. Please pray for many children and families to be reached with the Gospel!

At Casa Compasiva, we continue to grow in ministry to mothers and families. We have begun assisting births in a private clinic that provides a more dignified and supportive environment than what is typically available in the public system. Because this care is not affordable for many families, we are working to expand our scholarship fund to help those in need.

Please pray for God's provision in this area.

Our childbirth education classes are also growing, reaching many couples from the community. Each class ends with a devotional and prayer, opening doors to share Christ's love in a meaningful way.

We are thankful that Sara has begun a Master's degree in Perinatal Education. She will travel once per semester for in-person classes about 12 hours away.

Please pray for wisdom, strength, and financial provision for this new season.

We are also grateful for a missionary dentist who, over the course of six months, supported us with a mobile dental clinic. This was a tangible expression of Christ's love in our community.
