Motorcycles for Pastors in Haiti

Earlier this summer, a partner church sponsored a project to purchase motorcycles for our pastors in Haiti. Each month, we host the GMI-Haiti pastors at our headquarters in Limbé, where we have training sessions, share prayer requests, address needs, and provide fellowship, a meal, and lodging for the night. One of the greatest challenges to overcome is the lack of transportation availability. Many pastors do not own vehicles, and even if they do, fuel prices in Haiti are extravagant, sometimes costing a full day's wages for a single gallon. So, the motorcycle has become a fitting method of transportation, and these new bikes will be a means of significant blessing. As our churches are spread across multiple Departments (The equivalent of provinces or states), some pastors must travel great distances to attend the meetings.
